Geotechnical testing necessary for design would be considered as a part of such. Material testing during construction and as provided by the DB Contractor would be considered part of the construction services.

Specifically, it appears the current Electrical Maintenance Contractor would have conflict of interest due to their intimate knowledge of the existing traffic signal systems which would give them an unfair advantage over other Proposers. The Construction Oversight Team (COT) will be responsible for ensuring contract compliance during the construction and design of the project. For more details about the role of the COT, refer to the IPD Manual and Guidelines. The submittal requirements will be addressed in the RFP.
6	Section 2.2	N/A	What is the Department's expectation of design submittals, submittal turn-around times, etc? Will the the standard IDOT Phase II submittal process and milestones be followed? Or will an abbreviated submittal and review process be implemented?	The submittal requirements will be addressed in the RFP but anticipate expedited review and approvals.
7	Section 2.2	N/A	Will the Department be issuing a permit matrix and permitting assistance or is permitting the full responsibility of the DB Contractor?	Permitting will be the responsibility of the DB Contractor.
