No. 180	September 18, 2020 Letting
Certified Payrolls	Effective September 1, 2020, prime contractors and each subcontractor are required to file certified payrolls with the Illinois Department of Labor (IDOL) for projects covered by the State Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130) through the Illinois Prevailing Wage Portal. The portal can be found on the IDOL website at <u>https://www2.illinois.gov/idol/Laws-</u> <u>Rules/CONMED/Pages/Prevailing-Wage-Portal.aspx</u> . Payrolls shall be submitted in the format prescribed by the IDOL. Certified payrolls for projects covered by the State Prevailing Wage will no longer be accepted by IDOT. Paragraph 3 of Section IV (Compliance with the Prevailing Wage Act) of Recurring Special Provision #5 (Required Provisions – State Contracts) will not apply.
	Certified payrolls for projects covered by the Federal Prevailing Wage, i.e. Davis-Bacon Act, shall continue to be submitted to IDOT per current procedures. The IDOT makes the determination which prevailing wage (State or Federal) applies and includes the appropriate provisions in the bid proposal (and contract).
